## Accepted material for recycling:

### **NEWSPRINT**

Newspapers, office paper, shredded paper, stapled magazines and catalogs

### **CARDBOARD**

Corrugated cardboard only – boxes must be clean and flattened

### **#1 THRU #7 PLASTICS (recycling symbol on bottom of containers)**

Containers must be clean and without caps, labels are OK

### **CLEAR AND BROWN GLASS BOTTLES**

Containers must be clean and without caps, labels are OK
